MINUTES OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION/BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT
May 5, 2009

The City of Fifty Lakes Planning Commission/Board of Adjustments monthly meeting was held on Tuesday, May 5, 2009 in the City Hall at 7:00 p.m. The following officers were present: Judy Hansen, Chairperson, Duey Bendt, Nancy Brooks, Jack Riordan, and Jerry Olson Members. Tim Anick, Alternate Member. Gordy Reller, Planning & Zoning Administrator, Ann Raph, Deputy Clerk and 1 resident. Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

MOTION MADE BY MS. BROOKS AND SECONDED BY MR. RIORDAN TO APPROVE THE MINUTES AS AMENDED OF THE APRIL 7th, 2009 REGULAR MEETING. When polled: All members voted aye. Motion carried.

Unfinished Business:

Commission reviewed Ordinance 9.07 Parking, Storage and Usage of Recreational Vehicles. Discussion held on the sentence "Any use of a recreational vehicle greater than three (3) years will require an interim use permit." Commission does not recommend making any changes to this Ordinance at this time.

Gordy and Nancy attended a Planning & Zoning Meeting in Crosslake, Jack will be attending a Lakes and Rivers Conference in Rochester next week and Tim attended a Land Use Workshop, Basics of Planning and Zoning. Tim commented it was very educational and well worth the time to attend.

A committee was formed to review Temporary Use Structures in the City of Fifty Lakes and includes Jack, Gordy and Duey. Committee will report back in June.

The Downtown Mixed Use committee of Tim, Duey and Gordy has met and began reviewing options to create an Ordinance to address this use. Gordy is recommending to the Council that a joint meeting be held with Elizabeth Shevy, City Planner from Bloomington, and this Commission to review Downtown Mixed Use and a New Zoning District.

Gordy commented a new zoning map has been ordered. There will be a public hearing for a variance request at the June 2nd meeting.
